Dear Hon. Shearouse:

"I filed an appeal from the lower Court's denial of my Petition for Writ of Mandamus and Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis" in the above referenced case to the S.C. Supreme Court pursuant to S.C. Code, §24-27-400, as my appeal was based on unconstitutional presentments of my indictments by the state.

The S.C. Supreme Court granted my Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis, assigned the above referenced case number to my case, and transferred my case to the S.C. Court of Appeals for a disposition. Consequently, upon this transfer, the Court of Appeals charged me one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for my appeal and twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for my motion to proceed in forma pauperis contrary to the S.C. Supreme Court's decision.

Honorable Shearouse, since I originally appealed my case to the S.C. Supreme Court and was assigned a case number without prepayments of cost or fees, I assumed that the S.C. Supreme Court had granted my motion to proceed in forma pauperis. So, if I am correct, I am seeking your assistance in refunding my \$125 dollars that was taken by the S.C. Court of Appeals in violation of the S.C. Supreme Court's ruling and S.C. statutory law.

I would greatly appreciate your assistance in retrieving the unlawful court fees that was charged by Court of Appeals in this case.

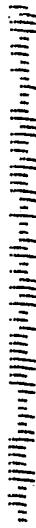
