

Enclosed for filing is the Amended Record along with a Proof of Service and Certificate of Counsel (Pro Se Appellant) in the referenced case.

Judge Short's Order on this case stated that I am to serve an amended record within thirty days of his Order. It was not clear to me whether that included filing the Amended Order with the Court as well within that period. To avoid any issue on this, I am filing the Amended Record with you for the Court this date, the date of service to counsels.

Rule 210 (c) states that each page is to be numbered consecutively. I have done that for the matter that was included by the Court after preparing all briefs and the Record for final by numbering some pages that were inserted as for example 38-1, 38-2, 38-3, etc. with the next page 39. This is not done but in two or three instances and is consecutive numbering. It represents a continuous numbering with one page following another without gaps which is my Webster edition definition of consecutive.

In accordance with a broad interpretation of Respondent Richland County Planning Commission's requested inclusion of exhibits all appendices to the Notice of Appeal and Appeal to the circuit court are included in the Record. The last item in the Amended Record is the exhibit Respondent requested as it was presented in the Notice of Appeal and Appeal. It is included in the unbound copy as the last page but will not readily photocopy. There also are sketch plans of the proposed project that fold out from the bound Amended Record. These may need hands on processing into the electronic version of the Amended Record.
