ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion to present additional evidence, a motion to amend the motion to present additional evidence, and a second motion to amend the motion to present additional evidence, requesting this court remand the matter to the Appellate Panel of South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce pursuant to section 1-23-380(3) of the South Carolina Code (Supp. 2014) for the taking of such additional evidence. Respondents have filed a motion to strike Appellant's application for leave to present additional evidence, which we construe as a return to Appellant's motion, and Appellant has filed a return, which we construe as a reply. After consideration, Appellant's motion for a remand to present additional evidence is denied. The merits of this issue will be considered once briefing is complete and the appeal has been submitted to a panel for consideration.

Respondents have filed a motion to dismiss, or in the alternative, a motion to strike Appellant's brief and designation of matter, and Appellant has filed a return. Respondents' motion is denied.
