To request Continuance

Now comes affiant, first being duly sworn upon his oath, and affirms the following statement as true and accurate to the best of his knowledge and belief:

1) I received a letter dated Dec. 15th notifying me of the 45 day deadline. Our dorm (F2) was locked down with no movement from Dec. 18th to Dec. 31st. That is times I lost from my 45 day deadline not being able to go to the law library.

2) I have documented proof within the S.C.D.C. grievance system that my access to the law library is being intentionally, and maliciously restricted by the librarian.

3) I have documented proof within the S.C.D.C. grievance system that my access to the law library is restricted by the rules of the dorm I live in. Our dorm is only allowed to go to the law library two days out of the week for limited hours while the rest of the regular population dorms are able to go every weekday for the full time that the law library is open.

The petitioner respectfully requests an additional 60 days due to the merits of my motion in support of continuance.

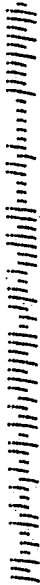
