Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing the record in this case, we have found it is incomplete. At the sentencing hearing, the judge announced he would sentence Hicks to the mandatory minimum sentences based on his past convictions if the State produced "a certification of these prior convictions" or "proof that these indeed are the correct charges." (R. 173-74). The record does not include any documents proving the prior convictions that might have been submitted, and it omits the sentencing sheets. Within ten (10) days, please supplement the record with the sentencing sheets and any documents filed with the trial court providing "certification of [his] prior convictions." (R. 173).
