

The Appellant Rhonda Meisner respectfully requests to amend the designation of matter on appeal and requests an additional 15 days after the Court enters its ruling on the motion to amend (the declaration of matter) to complete the corrections and submit the record on appeal. 



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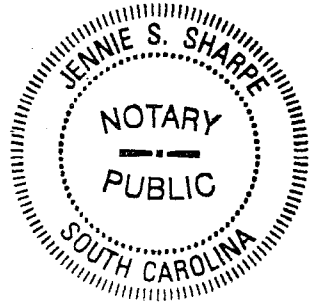
DECLARATION OF APPELLANT RHONDA MEISNER
