**Motion for an Extension of Time**

Pursuant to Rules 208 and 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellant Directory Assistants, Inc. moves this Court for an order granting a ten (10) day extension of time to file its Initial Reply Brief in the above-captioned appeal. This is Appellant's second extension request. **Counsel for Respondent has consented to this extension request.** Thus, no party will be prejudiced by this extension.
