ORDER

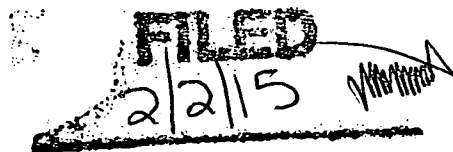
Appellant's motion to file the designation of matter out of time is granted.
