
We are in receipt of your letter dated January 12, 2015, in which you indicate the Court has not received any information regarding the transcript in the above-referenced matter. Our office provided a copy of a letter to the Court on January 2, 2015, a copy of which I am enclosing for your reference. In that letter, we notified the Office of Court Administration that we had not yet received the hearing transcript in this matter, nor in the companion cases of *Arrowpoint Capital Corporation v. SC Second Injury Fund, In re Joe Mathis v. Yuasa-Exide* (appellate case no. 2014-002212) and *In re: C.L. Williams v Yuasa-Exide* (appellate case no. 2014-000214). We received notification of an extension for the *C.L. Williams* matter only and clarified this issue with Ms. Sullivan, the court reporter.

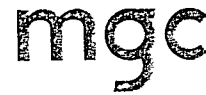

We are writing because, at the time of our request for the transcript of the C.L Williams matter, we also requested the transcripts for the two other above-referenced


