Dear Mr. and Mrs. McFarland,

This is to acknowledge that I have received your transcript request in the above-mentioned proceedings. I have reviewed my records and estimate that the transcript invoice will be approximately \$2,600 (approximately 800 pages). The State charges an additional \$35 for emailed transcripts if you require a pdf file in addition to the original.

Rule 607 provides that the rate of \$3.25 shall be charged per page for an original transcript of record. An up-front deposit is required to place the transcript in line for production. The deposit must be paid by a postal money order or a bank cashier's check, as I cannot accept personal checks.

If you end up overpaying me, then I would refund the difference, via a money order or cashier's check back to you, of course. If, however, the deposit does not cover the entire final invoice, I will contact you regarding the difference, and any additional funds must be received before delivery of the transcript.

Under our Rules, I have 60 days in which to complete the transcript after the receipt of your deposit. In addition, I am allowed to request from Court Administration 30-day extensions, if necessary, to complete the transcript. You will be notified if extensions are granted. If you desire to cancel the request for the transcript, a cancellation request must be made in writing.

You will be responsible for payment of any portion of the transcript that has been completed.
