MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Maurice Alphonso Roberts, Jr. respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, **until March 6, 2015**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Maurice Alphonso Roberts, Jr. respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time.
3. Counsel is working on and will be filing the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. James Scott Cross with this Court today, February 4,

2015. Counsel is also planning to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Christina Reece with this Court on Friday, February 6, 2015. Counsel is also planning to file the return to motion to seal or strike in the case of State of South Carolina v. Ricky Lee Blackwell with the Supreme Court on Friday, February 6, 2015. **Counsel has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender, including administrative and Appellate Project oversight. Counsel also has been training three new appellate defenders to include reading their briefs and certiorari petitions.**




6. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.


