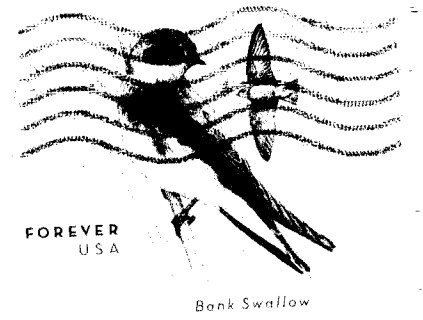
Since they testified at the trial, I do not see any reason to postpone your case to obtain this transcript. If you think this information or my decision is incorrect, please let me know as soon as possible.
