ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion to strike portions of Respondent's designation of matter and Respondent's initial brief. After review of the parties' filings, we grant Appellant's motion in part. Specifically, we strike the following designations from Respondent's designation on matter and any reference to these designations from Respondent's initial brief: (1) Deposition of James Trexler taken September 14, 2011; (2) Deposition of James Trexler taken May 15, 2013; (3) Deposition of Wayne Brennessel taken September 30, 2013; and (4) Articles of Organization of the HSPCA. Appellant's motion is otherwise denied.

Respondent shall serve and file an amended initial brief and an amended designation of matter in compliance with this order within thirty days. Appellant shall serve the record on appeal within thirty days of service of Respondent's amended initial brief and amended designation of matter.
