





Dear Ms. Hunt,

This is to acknowledge that on May 21, 2014 I received your transcript request for the above-mentioned proceeding. I have reviewed my records and estimate that the transcript invoice will be approximately \$92.80, which includes shipping. The State charges an additional \$35 for emailed transcripts if you also require a pdf file.

Rule 607 provides that the rate of \$3.25 for an original (or .75 for a copy) shall be charged per page for a transcript. Anything requested expedited is charged pursuant to State guidelines, and I can furnish that information if you require an expedited transcript. Upon receipt of your deposit funds I will place your request in line for production. If the final invoice is less than the quoted price, I will refund the difference to you upon delivery of the transcript; likewise, if it is more, the balance will be due prior to delivery of the transcript.

Under our Rules I have 60 days in which to complete the transcript after the receipt of your deposit. In addition, I am allowed to request from Court Administration 30-day extensions, if necessary, to complete the transcript. You will be notified if extensions are granted. If you desire to cancel your request for the transcript, a cancellation request must be made in writing. You will be responsible for payment of any portion of the transcript that has been completed.


