RE: The explanation of the dismissal, why it was not filed on time as required by the Court.

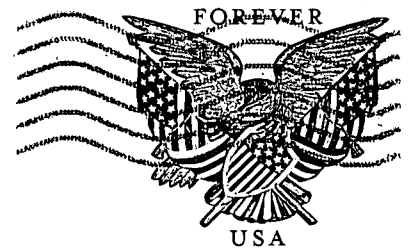
MS. Miles,
