I AM A PROSE LITIGANT, AND THIS MATTER AROSE FROM MY FILING OF A MOTION FOR AFTER NEWLY DISCOVERED EVIDENCE UNDER RULE 29(b), SCR CRIM. P., AND PURSUANT TO RULE 60(b) SCRPC. 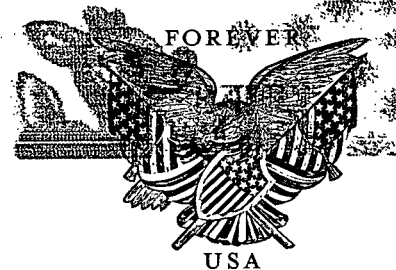
