ORDER

On October 24, 2014, this Court required Respondent to furnish Appellant "with copies of its record from the administrative law court proceedings" and ordered Appellant to serve and file the record on appeal thereafter. On October 30, 2014, this Court received proof that Respondent had complied with this Court's order. Respondent was not responsible for providing Appellant with a copy of his own brief as that is Appellant's responsibility. On December 29, 2014, this Court dismissed this Appeal because Appellant had still not served and filed either the record on appeal or Appellant's final brief. Appellant has now filed a petition for rehearing, requesting the Court to rehear the dismissal of this appeal and requesting Respondent to furnish more documents to him. Appellant's request for Respondent to furnish anything else to him is denied. This Court will act on the petition for rehearing upon receipt or the expiration of thirty days.
