MOTION FOR THE EXTENSION OF TIME TO SEEK CERTIORARI

Petitioner prays to be given a ten (10) day extension of time to complete the petition for certiorari to the Supreme Court for the above referenced case.

Attorney for petitioner has represented petitioner pro bono in accordance with the conditions of the 2013 Appellate Practice Project under the Honorable John Few of the Court of Appeals. The Court of Appeals affirmed Petitioner's convictions in State v. Jarrard 2014-UP-470 (Ct.App. 2014). Petitioner's sought rehearing but was denied on January 23, 2015.
