Pursuant to Rule 231 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules the Appellant files this motion. The Appellant moves for this Court to reinstate this appeal where it was dismissed for failure to file a proof of service for the notice of appeal stating the Respondant was served a copy of the notice of appeal as required by Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Due to no fault of his own the Appellant was delayed in receiving the notice sent out from this Court notifying him of his need within (10) ten days to correct the deficiency of the Court not receiving the above mentioned document in a letter dated January 13, 2015 to Perry Correctional Institution, being he was transferred to Evans Correctional Institution on January 15, 2015.
