ORDER

The time for petitioner to mail the petition for a writ of certiorari, and the appendix to the Division of Appellate Defense is extended until March 31, 2015. Once submitted to the Division of Appellate Defense, Appellate Defense shall, within ten (10) days thereafter, serve and file the copies required by Rule 243(d) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). It shall also provide the petitioner with a copy of these documents.

Petitioner is advised that he is responsible for ensuring that the petition and appendix comply with the requirements of Rule 243(e) and (f), SCACR. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in the dismissal of this matter.

Finally, petitioner is advised that any documents he wishes to file with this Court should be filed with the Clerk of this Court rather than with the Office of the Chief Justice.
