**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO REQUEST TRANSCRIPT**

---

Donald Lamon Young hereby requests an extension of 30 days from February 11, 2015 in order to request the transcript of his trial and sentencing. The trial was held on December 3 - 5, 2014, and Sentence was imposed on December 5, 2014 by the Honorable J. Mark Hayes, II. The Notice of Appeal was filed by mail on or about December 11, 2014. Mr. Young has not sent his Affidavit of Indigency to Appellate Defense, and the undersigned counsel was not retained to handle this appeal.

Based upon the requirements of the South Carolina Supreme Court's Order of March 18, 2009, counsel avers that there is good cause for this extension based upon counsel's information and belief based upon conversations with the Defendant's family wherein Defendant expressed a belief that counsel had sent the affidavit of indigency in an effort to sue the Defendant for something, presumably unpaid fees. Counsel believes that the purpose of the form has now been clarified and

that Defendant will sign it forthwith.

Based upon the foregoing, counsel respectfully requests another thirty (30) day extension up to and including March 13, 2015.





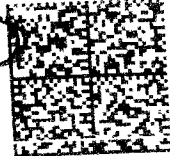
