1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case were due to be served and filed with this Court on December 8, 2014.


2. Appellant was previously granted an extension of 30 days, moving the deadline to January 7, 2015.

This extension would move the deadline to **Monday, January 12, 2015**.

4. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a five-day extension (through and including January 12, 2015) in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case. Counsel requests that the time limits for filing the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.




