ORDER

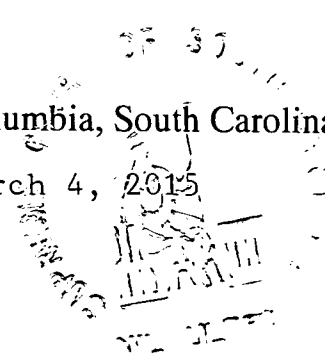
