Ms. Kitchings,

Your office should be fully aware of the facts, circumstances and laws concerning the above titled matter; therefore your letter of 2/18/15 must be viewed by any reasonable person as prejudicial. The prior motion to alter and amend per Rule 59(e), here in question, was submitted on the issue of the Appellants poverty. It is therefore irrational and illogical to ask for payment of a filing fee.

Consider applicable law; the A.P.A. governs review of an administrative agency decision and S.C.
