PETITION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND ACCOMPANYING APPENDIX

The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a **final thirty day extension, until April 13, 2015**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed on **Wednesday, March 12, 2015**.
2. Counsel is filing the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Bill Breland with the Court of Appeals on March 6, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Jacqueline Bacon with the

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. James McAbee with the Court of Appeals on February 9, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Vladimir Pantovich v. State with this Court on February 6, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Clarence Myers v. State with this Court on February 2, 2015.

3. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.


4. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty day extension, until April 13, 2015**. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
