
Appellants hereby move pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, for a short, 12-day extension of the time in which to serve and file Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal in this case. The grounds for this motion are that there is good cause to grant the requested extension, as the following shows:

1. The deadline for service and filing of Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal is currently tomorrow, March 4, 2015.
2. This is the second extension that the undersigned has sought in this appeal.
3. This appeal concerns a trial, and the length of the transcripts and volume of material in the record is thus greater than in many other appeals.
4. The undersigned counsel was recently ill with a very bad cold for over a week. The reduced pace of work occasioned by this has put him behind on virtually everything he has been working on, including the brief for this appeal.
5. Also, the undersigned now has a funeral to attend tomorrow afternoon, further reducing the amount of time available to complete the brief.
6. The undersigned has done substantial work on the brief already and does not need an additional 30-day extension of this deadline. A 12-day extension to March 16, 2015, should be sufficient to allow completion of the brief.

7. Appellants' counsel seeks a 12-day extension of this deadline in order to give him time to complete the brief.
8. Appellants' counsel does not anticipate seeking another extension absent truly extraordinary circumstances.
9. Appellant's counsel believes there is good cause to grant the requested extension to March 16, 2015.

WHEREFORE Appellants pray for an Order extending the time in which to serve and file Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal by 12 days, to March 16, 2015.




