## ORDER

---

Respondent has filed a motion to strike portions of Appellant's designation of matter, alleging several of the matters designated were not presented to the circuit court. Respondent's motion is granted. Within thirty days, Appellant shall serve and file an amended designation of matter that includes only those matters presented to the circuit court. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR (providing that the record on appeal shall not include any matter that was not presented to the lower court or tribunal). Specifically, we strike the following designations: (1) Recording of June 25, 2014 hearing; (3) Complaint against Judge Dean Ford; (5) Complaint against Mitchell Byrd; (9) Voicemails; and (10) Rule 5 Discovery. Appellant may include designation (8) in her amended designation of matter if the "Attorney Correspondence" was presented to the circuit court and if Appellant identifies the correspondence with specificity.
