

Dear Ms. Allen:

Thank you for your letter of February 11th concerning our agreement to mediate under the Pilot Program for Voluntary Mediation. We have the mediation set in these cases for March 18th, 2015 and I had already written defense counsel about our need to request an extension to allow mediation to be completed.
