


ORDER

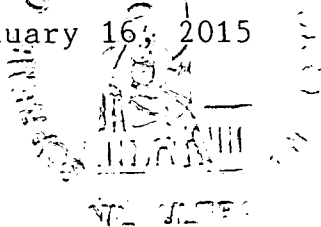
