This responds to your motion asking for reconsideration of this case.


The above appeal was dismissed by the Deputy Clerk of the South Carolina Court of Appeals on March 6, 2012. Under Rule 260(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), you had until March 21, 2012, move to reinstate the appeal. Therefore, your current motion is untimely as a motion for reinstatement.

Further, when you failed to timely file a motion for reinstatement, the Court of Appeals properly sent the remittitur to the lower court on March 22, 2012. Rules 221(b) and 260(a), SCACR. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case, and no further motions can be considered in this matter by either this Court or the Court of Appeals. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).

Accordingly, no action will be taken on your motion for reconsideration. I am


