

ORDER

Appellants filed a motion to reinstate this appeal, which was dismissed due to Appellants' failure to timely serve the record on appeal and file proof of service. On January 14, 2015, this court ordered Appellants to serve the record on appeal on Respondent and to file proof of service within ten days. The order provided that we would consider the motion to reinstate upon the expiration of ten days.

Although Appellants have now served and filed a record on appeal, the record does not include all of Respondent's designations of matter. *See* Rule 210, SCACR (providing the record on appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209, SCACR). Within ten days, Appellants shall serve and file a supplemental record on appeal, which includes all matter designated by Respondent that was omitted from the original record on appeal. Upon receipt of the supplemental record, or upon the expiration of ten days, this court will consider Appellants' motion to reinstate.
