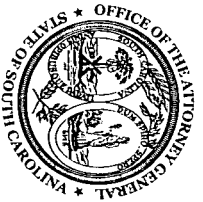
Dear Mr. Shearouse:

Please accept this letter in lieu of a formal Reply to Petition for Rehearing filed by the above referenced Petitioner. The Respondent asks this Court to deny the Petitioner's request for rehearing. By Order dated March 5, 2015, this Court granted certiorari on Petitioner's Question I and X and denied certiorari on all remaining questions. The Petitioner now asks this Court to reconsider its ruling and grant certiorari on several other questions. The Respondent submits the Petitioner is prohibited from petitioning for rehearing on issues this Court has previously declined to review. South Carolina Appellate Court Rule 221(a) explicitly states "No petition for rehearing shall be allowed from an order denying a petition for a writ of certiorari". The Petitioner has also failed to show this Court overlooked or misapprehended any particular points in its March 5 Order. For these reasons, the Respondent respectfully asks this Court to deny and dismiss the Petitioner Petition for Rehearing on the issues this Court previously declined to review.
