To the Supreme Court:


My counsel, Jonathan D. Waller has submitted a petition of writ of certiorari indicating that this appeal is without merit and requested to be removed as my counsel in this case. He filed a petition of an appeal on my behalf regarding Judge Murphy's decision. I have not seen a copy of the transcript from the PCR hearing. I believe that this case does have merit based on the enclosed information.

I would like to present to you a copy of the suicide letter (enclosed) that was not presented to Judge Murphy which was not considered in her decision of my case. My prior attorney, Ms. Ullman had in her possession the letter from the deceased victim (Mr. Joe Lijewski) during my first trial and she did not present it to the court.

At my PCR hearing in May, Ms. Ullman admitted that she did not present this letter from the victim, because she did not want to hurt his family. However, she did not take in consideration on how her statements to the court is hurting my family by not presenting this letter and keeping me away from my 94 year old mother.

This stressful ordeal is taking a toll on me and my family and causing my health to decline.

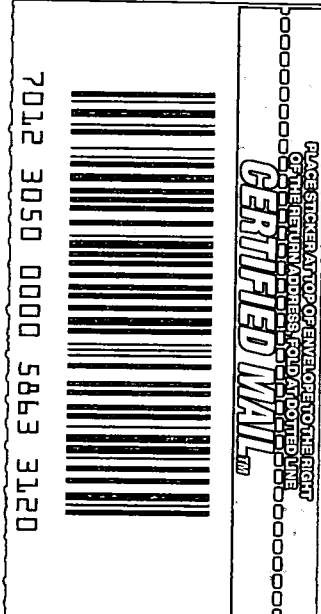
