Dear Mr. Shearouse:

I am writing to clear up any confusion that the Court may have regarding the Appendix for this matter. This is a capital case. Mr. Stone's Petition for Writ of Certiorari is currently pending before the Court following the denial of post-conviction relief.

On May 29, 2014, Mr. Stone filed a motion before this Court explaining that after the necessary Appendix materials were compiled and provided to an outside copying company for reproduction, it was discovered that some items which should have been included in the Appendix (including the first two volumes of the 1997 trial transcript) were erroneously not included. Rather than scrap the entire 12-volume Appendix, Mr. Stone requested permission to file a Supplemental Appendix containing the items that were erroneously excluded from the first production. This Court granted that motion on June 4, 2014, and Mr. Stone accordingly filed his Petition, the Appendix and the Supplemental Appendix together on June 12, 2014.

Thus, the first two volumes of the 1997 trial transcript appear in the Supplemental Appendix, which contains the original 1997 transcript index. Volume three of the trial transcript appears as the first page of the Appendix itself, and then the materials proceed from there as is typically the normal fashion – i.e., appellate briefing, the direct appeal opinion of this Court, the 2005 resentencing transcript, the appellate briefing and order regarding that direct appeal, the PCR applications and Return, the PCR hearing transcript and exhibits, the post-PCR hearing pleadings, the PCR Court's Order denying post-conviction relief, and the notice of appeal.


I hope this clarifies the order of the Appendix items for this case. Thank you for your time and attention to this matter.
