

Dear Mr. Gordon:

Upon reviewing your amended supplemental record on appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the pages are not numbered.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the attorneys for the respondent are not listed and the indictment numbers on appeal are not listed.
- One volume of a record on appeal cannot exceed more than 500 pages. Therefore, your record on appeal needs to be separated into volumes exceeding no more than 500 pages each. The front cover of each volume is to be the same as any record on appeal, only that it needs to be labeled as such: Volume 1 of however many volumes the record on appeal is.
