Dear Mr. Webb:

Upon reviewing your initial brief of appellant received March 20, 2015, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the pages are not numbered.
- The initial brief should be double spaced, not single spaced.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title of the document should be under the title of the case and the title of the case should be as follows:

Benny L. Webb, Appellant.

- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal nor was a proof of service showing a designation of matter had been served upon opposing counsel.
