APPELLANTS' RESPONSE TO S.C. COURT OF APPEALS' MOTION TO DISMISS**


On January 12, 2015 the Court Ordered Appellant to file and demonstrate that a Request for Transcript and to file Initial Brief and Designation of Matter .


