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The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a **final thirty day extension, until April 29, 2015**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the above-referenced case. Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of State v. Andre Decosta with the Court of Appeals on February 18, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Brian Stephens v. State with this Court on February 11, 2015.

3. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.




