Grand Jurors of Spartanburg County present upon their oath:

**ARSON, THIRD DEGREE: COUNT ONE**

That Hannah Dayle Manning did in Spartanburg County on or about August 16, 2013, willfully, intentionally, and maliciously set fire to, burn, or caused to be burned or aided in the burning of a dwelling located at 1401 unit A on Fernwood Glendale Road, Spartanburg, SC, in which Larry Dreiser was living, with the intent to destroy or damage the said dwelling, and that burning did result in damage to the dwelling, in violation of §16-11-110 (C) of *THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA*, (1976), as amended.

**ARSON, THIRD DEGREE: COUNT TWO**

That Hannah Dayle Manning did in Spartanburg County on or about August 16, 2013, willfully, intentionally, and maliciously set fire to, burn, or caused to be burned or aided the burning of a dwelling located at 1401 unit B on Fernwood Glendale Road, Spartanburg, SC, in which Samonaka Cheeks and her children were living, with the intent to destroy or damage the said dwelling, and that burning did result in damage to the dwelling, in violation of §16-11-110 (C) of *THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA*, (1976), as amended.
