

Dear Mr. Memering:

Upon reviewing your initial brief of appellant, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title of the document should be in the middle of the front cover, under the case number. Also, your full contact information should be listed on the front cover.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.
- A proof of service showing timely service upon opposing counsel has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. If the initial brief and designation of matter have not been timely served, a motion must be filed with this Court in order to accept these documents.
