We are in receipt of the Court's Order dated March 5, 2015 certifying the above-captioned appeal from the Court of Appeals. This purpose of this letter is to confirm the timing for serving and filing the initial briefs in this matter, which is a cross appeal.

BB&T Corporation, Branch Banking and Trust Company, and Sterling Capital Management, LLC are the primary appellants and have been designated as Appellants/Respondents. My client, Francis P. Maybank has cross appealed a single issue of the underlying Order and Final Judgment and has been designated as Respondent/Appellant. 
period under Rule 208(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules as commencing on the date of receipt by the parties of the last transcript so-transcribed and ordered.
