- 1) I am the petitioner in the above-captioned case, and I make this affidavit in support of the attached motion for an Order directing that I be furnished a copy of the transcript of the hearing without cost.
- 2) I am presently in the custody of the South Carolina Department of Corrections pursuant to orders of commitment of the Fairfield County Clerk of Court.

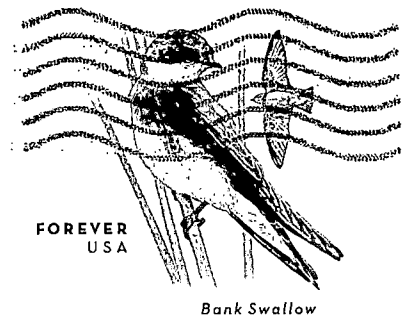
