Comes now the Appellant, Kevin Briggs, pro se, before this honorable Court to appeal from the Richland Court of Common Pleas, James R. Barber, the Honorable Circuit Court Judge, dated 02 March 2015. The Appellant received written notice of entry of this order (Judgment) on 09 March 2015. The Appellant submits this Notice of Appeal pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court Rule 243 (c), which requires an explanation.


The Appellant submits his Notice of Appeal pursuant to SC Appellate Court Rule (c) because the court denied the Appellant the relief he had requested. The court denied the Appellant based on "... court lacks jurisdiction to hear this complaint."

The order stated that the complaint of Kevin Briggs was heard; however, court records will show this was not the case. When the Appellant spoke, the judge stated he was unable to hear the complaint. The Appellant objected under South Carolina Constitution Article I, Section 22 stating that this complaint needed to be heard. The judge's response was "... the rules have changed."

The Respondent is basing its case on the Appellant not completing the grievance system the Respondent has put in place. The Appellant has shown that the grievance was completed and appeals what the Administrative Law Court ruled.

The Appellant has prepared a brief to support his claims and it will follow this notice of appeal.

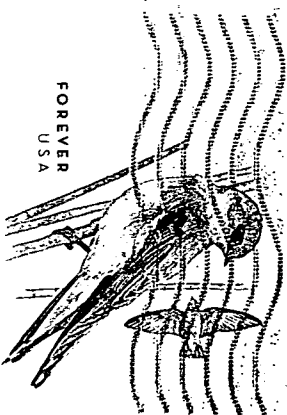

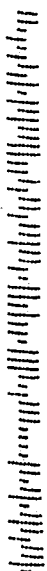
