My name is Richard A Green I am currently serving time in the South Carolina Department of Correction, and if possible, I would like your input and/or help in this situation.

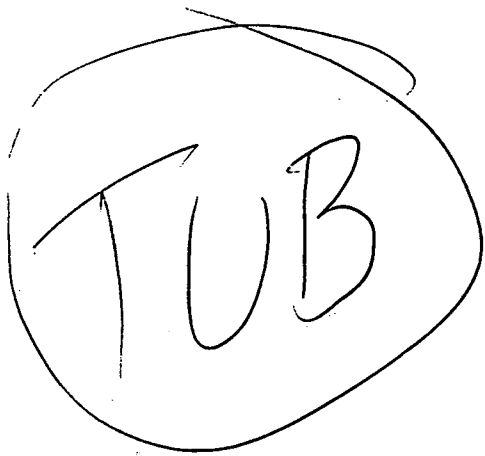

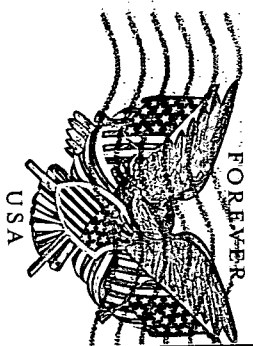
