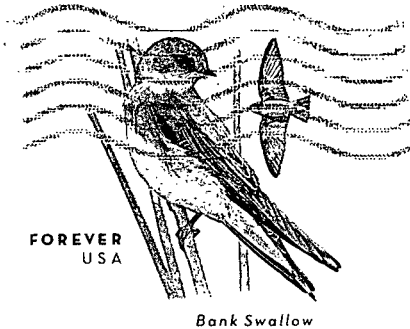
I also wrote her about video of trial.
