Dear Mr. Gordon:

The Court is in receipt of your letter dated April 2, 2015 inquiring about the letter sent by this Court on March 24, 2015. To answer your first question about the caption, you have the title of your case correct on your record on appeal. What was not correct on the front page of both the record on appeal and supplemental record on appeal is that where you list your contact information, you also need to include the attorneys for the respondent. You can see an example of what a cover page should look like for a record on appeal and supplemental record on appeal in the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules Appendix C, Form 15. The index should be the next page of your record on appeal and supplemental record on appeal.

For your second concern, we are returning your record on appeal and supplemental record on appeal with this letter to make the corrections concerning the issue with separating the supplemental record into volumes. When separating the supplemental record on appeal into volumes, you can just count until you reach 500 and that will be volume one. Then, starting at the next page, you will count another 500 and that will be volume two. Please make sure to number the pages, including the pieces of paper that were used to separated the documents in the

supplemental record on appeal. The front cover of each volume should state which volume it is in the upper right hand corner.

For your second concern about the problem with mailing in the corrected record on appeal and supplemental record on appeal, a cover letter explaining you had to mail the volumes separately is what you can provide noting this problem. Also, make sure to provide a proof of service that these corrected documents are served upon opposing counsel as well.

Provide these corrections within fifteen days of the date of this letter or your appeal may be dismissed.
