COUNT ONE - ARMED ROBBERY



COUNT TWO – POSSESSION OF A FIREARM DURING THE COMMISSION OF A VIOLENT CRIME

That the defendant, Jason Thomas Boston, did in Williamsburg County, South Carolina on or about March 14, 2014 knowingly possess and visibly display a firearm during the commission of the offense of armed robbery, a violent crime, in violation of §16-23-0490, South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
