

## ORDER

---

Appellant has filed several motions and a notice of appeal indicating he is appealing an order of the "Court of General Sessions, 5th Judicial Circuit" dated March 14, 2014 and an order denying Appellant's motion to reconsider the sentence dated April 21, 2014. Appellant's certificate of service indicates he served Respondent with the notice of appeal on October 9, 2014. Because Appellant failed to timely serve Respondent with a notice of appeal, this appeal is dismissed. *See* Rule 203(b)(2), SCACR ("After a plea or trial resulting in conviction or a proceeding resulting in revocation of probation, a notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within ten (10) days after the sentence is imposed. In all other cases, a notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within ten (10) days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment."); Rule 263(b), SCACR ("The time prescribed by these Rules for performing any act except the time for serving the notice of appeal under Rules 203 and 243 may be extended or shortened by the appellate court, or by any judge or justice thereof."). Because this appeal is dismissed, this Court declines to act on Appellant's pending motions.
