

ORDER

On December 30, 2014, this court relieved Appellant's retained counsel and held the appeal in abeyance for thirty days to allow Appellate Defense to make a determination of indigency. By letter of March 2, 2015, Appellate Defense notified this court that they sent letters and indigency affidavits to Appellant, but Appellant did not return the paperwork or send any other response.
