
1. Counsel was named counsel of record for this appeal by Order dated March 23, 2015.

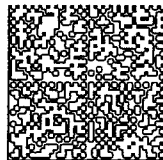
